## Exhibitor Information

**Schooling:** Hacking in the show ring will be permitted up until 15 min prior to the start time of show. There will be schooling available before division height changes. Horses and/or riders that are not competing are welcome to school, but must still register for a back number and pay the EMT fee per horse.

**Non-M&S Entries** are \$15/class

**M&S classes** are \$30-\$50/class as noted in the prize list

**Ring:** 105'x185 with slag/sand footing

**Rules and Regulations:**

1. Post entries will be accepted at no extra charge, but early emailed entries are most appreciated!!
2. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance herewith.
3. All Hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness with an emphasis on soundness and manners unless otherwise noted.
4. The CsF Horse Show, Cornerstone Farm Equestrian LLC., affiliates, affiliate property owners, or the staff volunteers, committee, etc. will not be held responsible for any accident, loss or damage which occur to any rider, horse, or equipment before, during, or after the show.
5. The committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, change location or add any class(es) or schooling deemed necessary.
6. Failure to enter the ring within 3 minutes of being called will incur elimination
7. All riders must wear proper attire including ASTM/SEI Safety approved head gear at all times while mounted.
8. **No Dogs** allowed on the show grounds. Any spectators or exhibitors with dogs will be asked to leave.
9. All fees must be paid and entry complete before numbers can be issued. Open Checks will be excepted for those who may want to add and close out at the end of the day.
10. It is a condition of entry to the show grounds that these rules and regulations be read, understood, and accepted.
11. A Junior rider is a rider who has NOT reached their 18th birthday as of Dec 1, 2016
12. A \$15 fee per entry will be charged for office and EMT.

**From the North East NJ/NY I-78:**


Take I-78 west to PA exit 75 for Easton. Turn left off of exit onto Morgan Hill Rd. Continue on Morgan Hill Rd through one stop sign to a second at the end of Morgan Hill Rd. Turn Right onto Raubsville Rd. Continue for approximately 1.5 miles and you slightly veer left onto Wassergass Rd at the intersection of Steely Hill Rd. (Raubsville Rd. continues at a sharp right here) Once on Wassergass Rd. you will continue to the intersection of Wassergass and Motil Rd and someone at that intersection will direct you to parking. Farm is on that corner.

**From North West PA:**

I-78 to exit 67 412 "Hellertown/Bethlehem" turn left off of exit heading South on 412. Make a left at the light for Cherry Lane (waffle house on the corner) Go to stop sign and turn left onto Easton Rd. Go approximately 3.9mi and make a sharp right up a steep hill onto Motil Rd. The farm is on the corner of Motil Rd and Wassergass and someone on Motil Rd. will direct you for parking.

**From the South:**

From route 611, turn onto 412 north. Take 412 to 212 and turn left onto 412 N/212 W. In less then a mile turn right onto Drifting Dr. (church on the corner before going through Sprintown) Take Drifting to the end and turn right onto Wassergass Rd. Farm will be about 1 mile on the right. If back roads are not for you do not turn onto Drifting Dr. continue straight until 412 and 212 split taking a right onto 412 North. Take 42 through the town of Hellertown almost to I-78. Turn right onto Cherry Ln. and continue following the directions above from that point.

## EQUITATION

### **Class 19 M&S 2'6 Child/Adult Medal      Entry \$30**

Open to Junior and Adult Amateur Riders on horses or ponies that are not competing at the same show in any class in which the fences exceed 3'. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences the required height including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse.

### **Class 12 M&S Children's Pony Medal      Entry \$30**

Open to Junior Riders on ponies that are not competing at the same show in any class in which the fences exceed 3'3". To be shown over a minimum of 8 fence at the required height with at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same pony must be used in all phases. Only one rider per pony. (Riders may not ride in more than one height section of the class.) Three riders must complete the course in order for points to count. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals. No cross entry of rider into the M&S Children's Horse Medal at the same show. May be combined with Child Horse and/or Adult Medal.

Open to all juniors 8 years old and younger. May not cross enter into any other divisions.

May not cross enter into any division with fence heights exceeding 2' Section A for riders who have not shown over fences more than 2' and section B for Horses who have not shown over fences more than 2'. Trotting in corners not penalized. Division will be split into the two sections if entries warrant. Please specify section on entry blank.

**Class 1 M&S Junior Medal 3'6**

**Entry \$30**

Open to Junior Riders. To be shown over minimum of 8 fences at 3'6" including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse.

**Class 5 M&S Jr/Amateur Horsemanship Medal 3'3 Entry \$30**

Open to Juniors and Amateurs. No cross entry restrictions. Over fences phases to be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at 3'3" including at least one combination and two changes of direction after the first fence. At least 12 riders, if available, to return to show on the flat. Flat phase to include the working walk, working trot sitting, working trot rising, work trot rising showing a lengthening of stride, working canter, working canter showing a lengthening of stride, and the counter canter (no more than 12 to counter canter at the same time). The same horse must be used in all phases. Running martingale or standing martingale allowed in the jumping phase. No martingales allowed in the flat phase. Change of bridle is permissible between phases.

**Class 11/10 M&S Sore No More Children/Adult Medal Entry \$30**

Open to Junior Riders on horses that are not competing at the same show in any class in which the fences exceed 3'3". To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences the required height including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course in order for points to count. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals. No cross entry of rider into the M&S Children's Pony Medal at the same show. May be combined with Adult and/or Pony Medal
